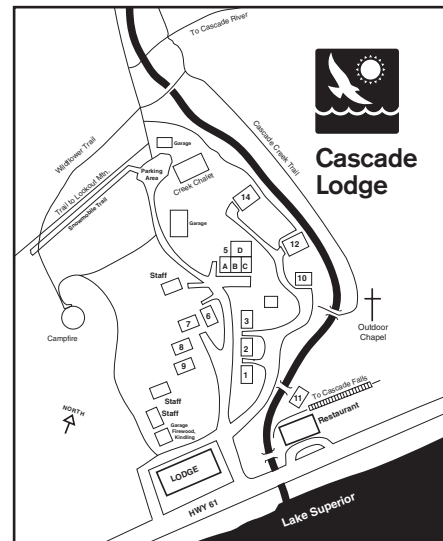

MAIN LODGE GUEST ROOMS

The main lodge offers 11 inviting guest rooms and one suite. All have coffee makers, refrigerators, and TV. Even numbered rooms face the lake.

Room 101, 103: 1 Queen bed and kitchenette

Suite 104: 1 Bedroom king, living room w/sleeper sofa, fireplace, refrigerator/microwave, oversize whirlpool in bath

Odd Numbered Rooms: (201, 209, 211) 2 Queen beds, 4 per., 211 has whirlpool

Even Numbered Rooms: (204-214) 1 Queen bed, (202) 1 King bed

PIONEER RUSTIC LOG CABINS

Cabins 1, 2, 3 and 11: All have living room area and bedroom area, separated by a partition wall. Living room areas have full size sleeper sofa or futon, table and chairs and fireplace. Each have porches with chairs. There is a refrigerator and microwave but no kitchen in these cabins.

Cabin 1 & 11: 1 Queen bed, futon, fireplace. Max 4.

Cabin 2: 1 Queen bed, single bed, futon, stone fireplace. Max 5.

Cabin 3: 2 Queen beds, futon, free standing fireplace. Max 6.

LUXURY CABINS

Cabin 7: 1 Bedroom with queen, sleeper sofa, kitchen, fireplace, large whirlpool. Max 4.

Cabin 12: 2 Bedrooms, 1 queen, 1 king, futon, kitchenette, fireplace, large whirlpool. Max 6.

Cabin 14: 2 Bedrooms, 1 queen, 1 king, futon, full kitchen, fireplace, whirlpool. Max 6.

CABINS

Cabin 6: 1 Bedroom w/queen bed, futon, rollaway, kitchenette, freestanding fireplace. Max 5.

Cabin 8: 1 Queen bed, Max 2.

Cabin 9: 1 Queen bed, futon. Max 4.

Cabin 10: 1 Bedroom w/queen bed, futon, kitchenette, freestanding fireplace. Max 4.

VACATION HOME

CREEK CHALET: 2 Levels, 4 bedrooms, full kitchen, kitchenette, fireplace, washer/dryer. Max 12.

MOTEL UNITS (5A, B, C and D)

The units are in a four-unit building with three units facing the lake. Three units include 1 queen bed, rollaway, microwave and refrigerator. Max 3/unit. The fourth unit (D) is a 2 queen bedroom apartment with kitchenette and futon. Forest side. Max. 6.
